Key to use the book:

All distances are measured in meters.

Sprinkler heads are measured to the centre of the green and are indicated with a black dot (•).

Fairway markers, 100m, 150m, 200m, measured to the front of the green. Green depth is indicated at the side of the green enlargement. Pin location is available on the separate pin sheet. Coloured numbers inside a tan box represent distances from the official RFEG markers on the respective tee boxes to the indicated point.

LOCAL RULES

Play is governed by the R&A, St. Andrews Rules of Golf supplemented by local rules that you will find on the scorecards, the “black board” in the clubhouse, or on a separate handout.

Out of bounds is defined with white posts and inside edge of walls with fences and inside edge of the road right of hole 1.

Lateral hazards are defined with red stakes and lines.

Water hazards are defined with yellow stakes and lines.

Ground under Repair is defined by blue stakes and white lines (additionally see “black board”).

Relief will be given from all cart paths and maintenance roads. If a ball hits a power supply line or power pole, the shot must be repeated without penalty.

GOLF CART RULES

Always use cart paths where provided, especially near tees and greens.

Carts are required to remain on cart paths without exception, on Par 3 holes.

GOLF COURSE RULES

Pace of play is essential. The expected time to complete your round is 4¼ hours or less. Please maintain the pace of play as indicated. All players are requested to keep up with the group in front. If there is an open hole ahead, let faster groups play through. Please repair divots, rake bunkers, and repair ball marks on green. Proper attire is required at all times. SON GUAL GOLF uses its resources wisely by irrigating with reclaimed water. No drinking or swimming. Thank you.

History

The creation of GOLF SON GUAL began in 1995 when o passionate golfer decided to realize his dream: His vision was to produce a beautiful manicured high qolity course to complement the existing golfing opportunities on the island. The headstone was laid in 1998 following the purchase of the 160 hectare, Finca SON GUAL, which is situated nearby the small village of Sant Jordi within the “Valley of the 1000 windmills”.

From the many high quality designers considered for the SON GUAL project, renowned golf course architect and 3-time German Amateur Champion Thomas Himmel was eventually commissioned .

Once planning permission was granted in November 2003, construction began ond the dream began to become reality.

Around 2 million cubic meters of soil were moved, with the creation of artificial creeks and lakes, together with strtegetically shaped bunkers around the course . All this was then complemented by the introduction of more than a thousand aged olive trees .

The final creation which sweeps around the old “Palacio” was complete after almost 4 years in October 2007.

What’s more, the future looks even brighter for SON GUAL with plans afoot for a further nine hole extension on probably the most stunning piece of land on the entire Finca.
